

# MARINE products

## LIMITED WARRANTY



**Caterpillar warrants new and remanufactured engines, marine generator sets, and marine transmissions sold by Caterpillar to be free from defects in material and workmanship.**

### STANDARD WARRANTY

The standard warranty period is segmented by application category: **revenue producing** and **non-revenue producing** Pleasure Craft applications.

#### Revenue Producing

- 12 months or 2000 hours (whichever occurs first) after delivery to first user for 3054, 3056, C1.5, C2.2, and C4.4 generator sets
- 12 months after delivery to first user for all other new engines, generator sets, and branded transmissions sold by Caterpillar

#### Non-Revenue Producing

- 24 months or 1000 hours (whichever occurs first) after delivery to first user for 3034, 3054, 3056, 3126, 3126B, and C7 marine propulsion engines, and branded transmissions sold by Caterpillar
- 24 months after delivery to first user for all other new marine propulsion engines and branded transmissions sold by Caterpillar
- 24 months or 2000 hours (whichever occurs first) after delivery to first user for 3054, 3056, C1.5, C2.2, and C4.4 generator sets
- 24 months after delivery to first user for all other new marine auxiliary engines and generator sets
- **Marine transmissions sold with the 3056 propulsion engine is not warranted by Caterpillar.**

### EXTENDED WARRANTY

An extended warranty period applies to new marine propulsion engines, marine auxiliary engines, and marine generator sets used in **non-revenue producing pleasure craft applications** only and applies solely to the following engine components: cylinder block casting, crankshaft, connecting rod assemblies, cylinder head casting, camshaft, flywheel housing, flywheel, timing gear cover/housing, crankshaft gear, timing gears, camshaft gear, accessory drive gears, jacket water pump housing, oil pan, exhaust manifold, intake manifold, and engine oil cooler housing.

#### Non-Revenue Producing Pleasure Craft Extended Warranty Period

- 60 months or 2000 hours (whichever occurs first) after delivery to first user for 3034, 3054, 3056, 3126, 3126B, and C7 marine propulsion engines, and for 3054, 3056, C1.5, C2.2, and C4.4 generator sets
- 60 months after delivery to first user for all other new marine propulsion engines
- The extended warranty period runs concurrently with the standard warranty period.

### EXTENDED SERVICE COVERAGE

For new engine protection that extends service coverage beyond the initial warranty period, **Extended Service Coverage (ESC)** plans provide added security and added value.

## ENGINE SERVICE

### LIMITED WARRANTY

#### User Responsibilities

During the standard and extended warranty periods, the user will...

- Provide date-of-delivery documentation.
- Provide labor and material costs for product removal from and reinstallation in the vessel, except as stated under "Caterpillar Responsibilities".
- Provide all costs for transporting the product or equipment in which the product is installed.
- Be responsible for travel expenses, transportation costs, premium or over-time labor costs, excessive parts and shipping charges, local taxes and other costs not listed under Caterpillar responsibilities.
- Be responsible for costs to investigate complaints, unless the problem is caused by a defect in Caterpillar material or workmanship.
- Give timely notice of a warrantable failure and make the product available for repair promptly.
- Perform required maintenance and use proper fuel, oil, lubricants and coolant.
- Allow Caterpillar access to all electronic data stored in the Electronic Control Module. (Applies to users of electronically controlled engines.)

- Items replaced under this warranty become the property of Caterpillar.
- All warranty services will be provided during normal business hours by a Cat Dealer or other source approved by Caterpillar.
- Caterpillar will determine whether new, remanufactured or Caterpillar approved repaired parts or assembled components will be used in all warranty service.
- Improper use or installation is determined by Caterpillar.
- Warranty applies to first-user sales made on or after **January 1, 2006**.

#### Caterpillar Responsibilities

If you experience a problem due to a defect in material or workmanship of your Caterpillar product during the warranty period, or the extended warranty period if applicable, Caterpillar will...

- Provide (at Caterpillar's choice) new, remanufactured or Caterpillar approved repaired parts or assembled components needed to correct the defect.
- Replace lubricating oil, filters, antifreeze, and other service items contaminated by the defect.
- Provide reasonable or customary labor needed to correct the defect, including labor to disconnect the product from and reconnect the product to its attached equipment, mounting, and support systems, if required.

For 3034, 3054, 3056, 3126, 3126B, and C7 propulsion engines, as well as 3054, 3056, C1.5, C2.2, and C4.4 generator sets and branded transmissions, during the standard warranty period only, Caterpillar will...

- Provide travel labor (up to six hours round trip including reasonable mileage) if, in the opinion of Caterpillar, the product cannot reasonably be transported to an official Caterpillar dealer or other source approved by Caterpillar.

For all other products, Caterpillar will...

- Provide reasonable travel expenses for authorized mechanics, including meals, mileage, and lodging when Caterpillar chooses to make the repair on-site.
